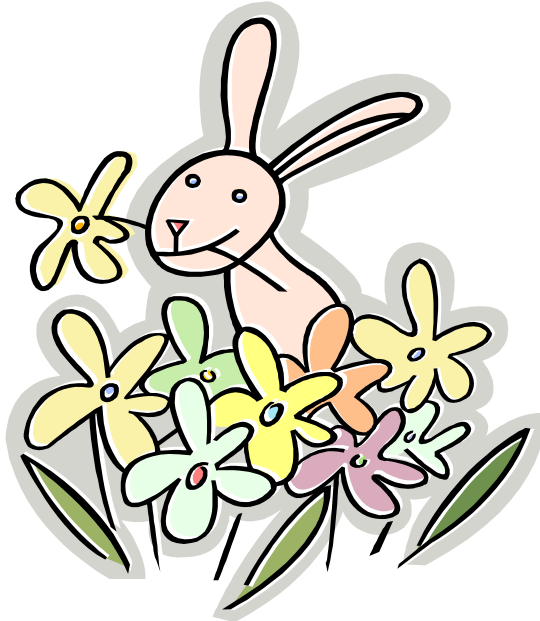

 Welcome to the Spring Term.

 learning about the sounds of the alphabet. We
